

Located a short distance from Washago, this 223 acre Nature Reserve provides examples of wet hardwood forests, groves of conifers and hardwoods, a dynamic stream wetland and barren rock ridge. The south parcel was donated to The Conservancy by Elizabeth Monck Hope Smith in 2007 the north parcel was obtained from Stan Hope Smith in 2008 and is held in title by the Ontario Heritage Trust.
