

If you don't yet have a citizen science badge, let us know. We'll arrange to leave one in the mailbox at the office for you to pick up.

If you go, please adhere to the following safety procedures:

- 1. If you are feeling ill, please stay at home.
- 2. If you are going to a monitoring site with your partner who is not from the same household, please **drive separately**.
- 3. Please **wear masks** when monitoring. If you do not own a mask, let us know and we will provide you with one.
- 4. Please stay **at least 6 feet** (we'd be more comfortable with 12 feet) from your partner and anyone you encounter.
- 5. Please do not share equipment (pencils, recording devices, etc.)
- Please wear your citizen science badge, and print off this "Volunteers at Work" sign and put it on the dash of your car and carry an extra copy with you.
- 7. Your safety, and the safety of the public, are far more important than your monitoring visit. If at any time you feel the need to turn around and go home, please do not hesitate to do so.
