## **Preparing Before Visit**



First, click on the Landscape app on your device.

Once inside the app you will be able to see your current location. If you are at a Stewardship site the boundary of the site will be outlined in green.

By clicking the search bar, you can see all stewardship sites in the area. By clicking "Show Team Sites", you can see all of the Stewardship sites your team is responsible for.

Clicking on any of these sites will bring you to the site-location on the map.





Press "Yes" to begin downloading the data for offline use. While connected to wi-fi click "Prepare Offline", doing this will allow the app to track the events of your visit without the use of your cellular data.

(Optional if site has consistent cell service)





# Press "OK" to click out of this tab.

It will continue to download the site in the background.





Make sure that "Stewardship Site-Specific" and "Structures/Uses" are both turned on.

\*if you are a Grassland Bird Surveyor it is best to have only 'Stewardship Site-Specific' turned on.

When most people think of the Couchiching Conservancy, they think of Grant's Woods. This Nature Reserve is the location of our office and a popular destination for a relaxing walk in the woods on one of the four kilometres of loop trails.

The Grant family purchased this property in 1908, and in 2002 William Grant donated it to the Conservancy in memory of his late brother Jack.

A former house on the property has been extensively renovated to create the Conservation Centre office. Thanks to a grant from the Ontario Trillium Foundation and a legacy gift from the estate of Bill Grant, our office and gazebo are fully accessible, the office is heated and cooled geothermally, and 50% of our annual hydro bill is offset through solar power generation.

## **Taking Photos**

Take a picture during your visit by pressing the camera button on the top right of your screen.





If you click on the photo option, it will bring you to this screen. By clicking this button you may take your photo.



Once the photo is taken, you will see a few options on the bottom of your screen.

Here, you can either describe what the image is showing, discard the image or keep the image.

Please add a description to any photo being kept.

This screen will appear when adding a description to a photo.

The description can be as long or brief as needed, but having a description is important for interpreting the data later on.



If you want to make a point of interest on the map click the pencil icon. Points will automatically be placed at your current location





Once you have clicked on the pencil icon, you can click the top green button to make the point on the map OR click the thumbs down button decline the option to make a point.



If you want to make the point simply check the "yes" when you get to this screen.

Clicking on the point will give you the option to edit your point or you can remove it.
