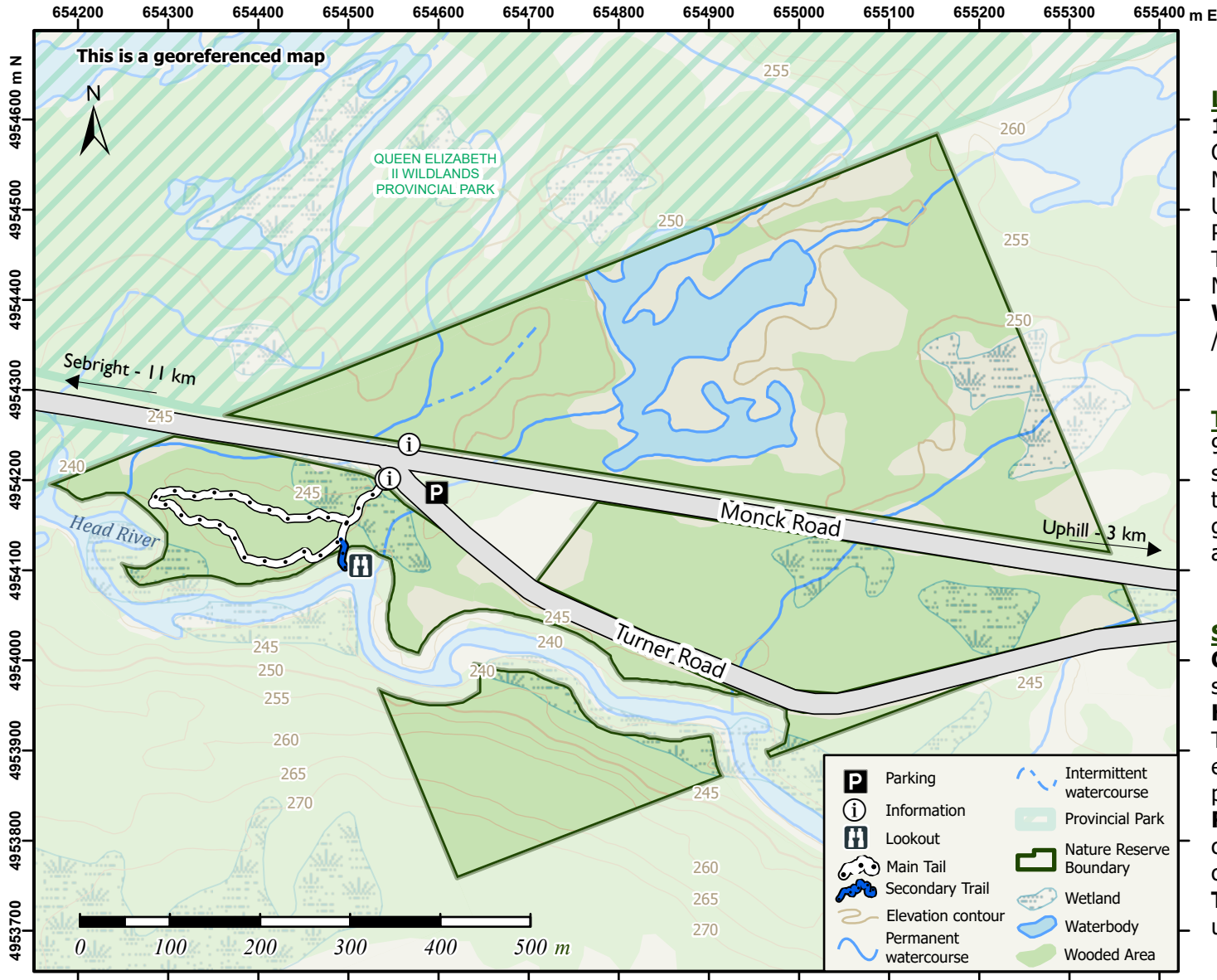
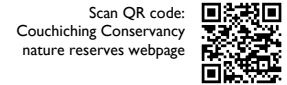


Kris Starr Sanctuary Nature Reserve



Location and Parking

17 Turner Road, Kirkfield. Along County Road 45, also known as Monck Road, between Sebright and Uphill.

Parking on Turner Road near South Trail entrance. Do not park on Monck Road.

Trail Details

900 m, upland trail with a secondary trail to the lookout on the Head River. 12 m elevation gain, with a gradual slope peaking at the west end of the trail.

Safety

Cell Service: There is no cell service here.

Hunting: Hunting occurs nearby. Trailheads will be posted with a "No entry" sign when a hunt is in progress.

Road: Use extreme caution if crossing roads (high-visibility clothing recommended).

Ticks: Check yourself for ticks after using the trails.
