- **Strengthening Physical Health:** Physical well-being is also enhanced through regular outdoor activities, which helps reduce risks of chronic diseases, improves sleep, and lowers blood pressure.
- **Building Community and Social Cohesion:** Nature not only benefits individuals but also communities by fostering social interaction, increasing a sense of belonging, and even reducing crime rates in areas with more greenery.
